### **Contest Eligibility Rules:**

- 1. A false statement on this contest entry application can cause disqualification of the contestant.
- 2. Contestants shall be evaluated on: (a) high school grade point average, (b) 500-word essay, (c) personal resume (a biographical information statement), community or volunteer service experience, community leadership experience/participation, (d) two letters of recommendation, and (e) personal interview.
- 3. The following criteria shall be used for judging:
  - a. Fifteen percent (15%) Grade point average from school transcript.
  - b. Twenty percent (20%) 500-Word essay "Volunteerism and Its Importance" tell why you feel volunteerism is important in a young person's life. Please site specifics to exemplify your statements. Please attach to application
  - c. Twenty percent (20%) Personal resume (biographical information statement), please attach to application, and complete the form on page 3, "Community or Volunteer Service Experience / Community Leadership Experience."
  - d. Fifteen percent (15%) Two letters of recommendation, excluding family members.
  - e. Thirty percent (30%) Personal interview.
- 4. Contestants must be enrolled in school either public/charter school/private school/home school, and currently be in the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

- 5. The contest shall be conducted in the English language and all contestants shall speak and write in English when participating in Lions Club activities.
- 6. The Lubbock Lions Club Outstanding Youth Program consists of two separate contests, one for the young men and one for the young ladies. One winner will be selected for each of the two categories.
- 7. Each contest winner will be awarded a ONE THOUSAND-DOLLAR SCHOLARSHIP! This will be paid at such time as you enroll in and enter into your post-high school education in an institution such as a university, college, junior college, or vocational training program. The winner will provide us with a copy of their billing statement and proof of enrollment from the college of their choice and we will write the check directly to that college on behalf of the winner

## **Duties & Responsibilities of the Winners:**

- 1. The winners will serve as the Lubbock Lions Club Outstanding Youth for a one year term and will begin serving immediately after winning the contest.
- 2. It is a REQUIREMENT that the winners will attend the meetings as much as possible or at the least, one meeting per month, each Tuesday at noon, at the Scottish Rite Center. We understand that there will be rare occasions when the winner is not able to be with us and will work with your school schedule.
- 3. It is a REQUIREMENT that the winners participate in the fund raising projects: the Pancake Festival, 4<sup>th</sup> Of July Flag Sales, and Bell Ringing for the Salvation Army.
- 4. Although we do not expect it, should the winner be unable or unwilling to fulfill their duties during their one-year term, Lubbock Lions Club reserves the right to modify (including forfeiture) the scholarship in accordance to the level of participation the winner was able to provide. The selected Outstanding Youth winners will find our members to be very friendly and will welcome you with special honor at each of our meetings.

# **Application Information and Deadline**

- 1. Contest applications must be received by 3:00 p.m. October 5, 2016.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation must be received in the Lubbock Lions Club Office by 3:00 p.m. October 5, 2016. One letter is required from the contestant's school by a teacher, principle or counselor. The other letter can be from a pastor, or someone in the community. None of the letters can come from any person who is a relative of the contestant.
- 3. The letters of recommendation must be mailed by the letter's author directly to Lubbock Lions Club #4 Briercroft Office Park, Lubbock, TX 79412. These must be received by 3:00 p.m. October 5, 2016. (They may also be emailed to <a href="mailed-lubloocklions.org">lubloocklions.org</a> or faxed to 806-763-7324 by 3:00 p.m. October 5, 2016.)
- 4. A recent photograph, preferably a headshot, should be attached to this application, see page 3.
- 5. Judging and interviews of applicants will take place on Monday, October 10, 2016, beginning at 3pm, at the Lubbock Lions Club office, #4 Briercroft Office Park. Appointments for the interviews will be scheduled for each eligible contestant.
