ELIGIBILITY RULES:

- 1. Any false statements on this application WILL result in automatic disqualification.**
- Applicant shall be evaluated on the following criteria:
 - Thirty percent (30%) – Personal interview with a panel of judges (appearance, dress, body language, etc.) as well as community/volunteer/leadership experience (see page 3)
 - Thirty percent (30%) – 750 word essay on the topic “Making an Impact - Making a Difference”. Contestant’s essay should detail positive actions they have taken or would take to be the *Change* they want to see in their school, community and world. Contestants must articulate, why change is so important and *What* change will you do to make a difference. The essay must be well organized, show use of good vocabulary/proper grammar and meet the required length. (Please attach to the application)
 - Twenty percent (20%) – Grade point average from school administrator (Please use enclosed form)
 - Twenty percent (20%) – Two letters of recommendation (excluding family members).
- Applicant must be currently enrolled in 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade within Lubbock County.
- The personal interview shall be conducted in English. Recipient(s) of the scholarship shall speak and write English when participating in Lions Club activities.
- The Lubbock Lions Club Outstanding Youth “We Serve” Scholarship program is designed for participation by young men and women. Up to two (2) scholarships may be awarded based on judges overall scoring.
- Each scholarship recipient will be awarded a ONE THOUSAND DOLLAR SCHOLARSHIP! This scholarship shall be paid at such time as you enroll in your post-high school education at an institution such as a university, college, junior college, or vocational training program. Recipient(s) will be required to provide the Lubbock Lions Club with a copy of their billing statement and proof of enrollment from said institution at which time a check will be sent directly to the institution on behalf of the recipient.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF WINNER(S):

1. The recipient(s) will serve as the Lubbock Lions Club Outstanding Youth for a term of one (1) year and will begin serving immediately upon award of the scholarship.
2. It is a **REQUIREMENT** that the recipient(s) attend weekly meetings as often as possible, but at least once per month.
 - Outstanding youth will sit at the head table with the Lion Boss
 - Outstanding youth are the **only** members of the club that can fine the Lions Boss
 - You may be asked to speak from the lectern on occasion
 - You should be willing to participate in skits with the Spirit Committee (Tail Twisters)
3. Meetings take place at noon each Tuesday at the Scottish Rite Center or other location as designated. We understand that there will be occasions when the recipient(s) are not able to attend. The Lubbock Lions Club will be happy to provide a letter to your teacher/counselor and will work with your school schedule to the extent that we can.
3. In lieu of attendance/participation at weekly meetings, recipient(s) will be encouraged to participate in ongoing service projects through the WE SERVE Committee such as Adopt-A-Highway, Salvation Army monthly meal prep/service, South Plains Food Bank, etc.
4. It is a **REQUIREMENT** that the recipient(s) participate in our annual events throughout the year, i.e.
 - Pancake Festival
 - Kids Fish
 - 4th Of July Flag Sales
 - Salvation Army Bell Ringing

Recipient(s) should check in on the Lubbock Lions Club Facebook page and post pictures.

5. Although we don't anticipate it, should the recipient(s) be unwilling or unable fulfill their duties during their one-year term, the Lubbock Lions Club reserves the right to modify or forfeit the scholarship in accordance with the level of participation by the recipient(s). You will find that our members are very friendly and will welcome you with special honor at each of our meetings.

1. **Scholarship applications must be received (hand delivered, by U.S. mail or e-mail) no later than 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 12, 2019.**
2. Two letters of recommendation must be received from the letter's author in the Lubbock Lions Club Office by **3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 12, 2018 (hand delivered, by U.S. mail or e-mail).** Letters should come from the applicant's teacher, principal, counselor or other adults who may know you well including a pastor, youth director or other community leader familiar with your community/volunteer service and/or leadership. Recommendation letters may NOT come from a relative of the applicant.
3. Please attached a recent photograph (preferably a headshot) to this application (see page 4)
4. Personal interviews with our panel of judges will take place on **Saturday, November 16th** at the Lubbock Lions Club office, 2526 82nd Street, Suite D. Appointments will be scheduled with all eligible applicants.
