ELIGIBILITY RULES:

- 1. Any false statements on this application WILL result in automatic disqualification.
- 2. Applicant shall be evaluated on the following criteria:
 - a. Written statement essay including involvement with Lions Club, volunteer service, leadership experience, and participation commitment (30%)
 - b. Personal interview with a panel of judges (appearance, dress, body language, Lions, community, volunteer, leadership experience) (50%)
 - c. Two letters of recommendation (excluding family members) (20%)
- 3. Applicant must be currently enrolled in 9th, 10th, or 11th grade within Lubbock County.
- 4. The personal interview shall be conducted in English. Recipient of the scholarship shall speak and write English when participating in Lions Club activities.
- 5. The Lubbock Lions Club Dick Van Hoose Memorial Outstanding Youth Intern program is designed for participation by young men and women. The scholarship will be awarded based on judges overall scoring.
- 6. The intern will be awarded a TWO THOUSAND DOLLAR SCHOLARSHIP! This scholarship shall be paid at such time as you enroll in your post-high school education at an institution such as a university, college, junior college, or vocational training program. The recipient will be required to provide the Lubbock Lions Club with a copy of their billing statement and proof of enrollment from said institution at which time a check will be sent directly to the institution on behalf of the recipient.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF WINNER:

- 1. The recipient will begin serving upon award of the internship as the Lubbock Lions Club Dick Van Hoose Memorial Youth Intern and serve through June 30, 2023.
- 2. It is a **REQUIREMENT** that the recipient attend weekly meetings as often as possible, but at least once per month.
 - Lubbock Lions Club Dick Van Hoose Memorial Youth Intern will sit at the head table with the Lion Boss.
 - Lubbock Lions Club Dick Van Hoose Memorial Youth Intern is the **only** member of the club that can fine the Lions Boss and Tail Twisters.
 - You may be asked to speak from the lectern on occasion.
 - You should be willing to participate in skits with the Spirit Committee (Tail Twisters).

Meetings take place at noon each Tuesday at the Scottish Rite Building or other location as designated. We understand that there will be occasions when the recipient is not able to attend. The Lubbock Lions Club will be happy to provide a letter to your teacher/counselor and will work with your school schedule to the extent that we can.

Recommendation letters may NOT come from a relative of the applicant.
