REQUIREMENTS

1. Any false statements on this application will result in automatic disqualification.
2. Applicant shall be evaluated on the following criteria:
 - We'd love to get to know you better! Please submit a short video (minimum of two minutes, maximum of three minutes in a .mp4 file extension) introducing yourself and sharing why you're interested in this scholarship opportunity. Video may include, but is not limited to:
 - Discuss your community volunteer experience.
 - Discuss your community leadership experience.
 - Discuss your extracurricular activities.
 - Discuss any part-time jobs held.
 - Discuss what you know about or your involvement with a Lions Club.
 - In two or three sentences, explain what this scholarship would mean to you if you were selected and what difference it may make in your continued education career path.
 - We want to get a sense of your personality and communication style. You can read from a script, use a .ppt, use props, etc. Be funny, be creative, make it you!
 - A virtual or in-person interview will be required by the finalists with the committee. The interview will be conducted in English.
 - Two letters of recommendation (excluding family members).
 - Completed and executed Video Submission Release and Liability Waiver is attached.
3. Applicant must be currently enrolled in 10th or 11th grade in a public, private, or home school in Lubbock County.
4. The intern will be awarded a \$2,000.00 SCHOLARSHIP! This scholarship shall be paid at such time as you enroll in your post-high school education at an institution such as a university, college, junior college, or vocational training program within two years of graduation from high school.
5. The Evaluation Criteria that will be used, but is not limited to, in the evaluation of the applicants is attached.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF RECIPIENT

1. The recipient will begin serving upon selection and serve through May 1, 2027.
2. It is a **REQUIREMENT** that the recipient attend a total of three meetings throughout the term of service. Lubbock Lions Club meets year-round with the exception of two weeks during Christmas/New Year holidays.
 - The scholarship recipient will sit with your assigned mentor at our meetings.
 - The scholarship recipient is the **only person** in the club that can access a fine on the Lion Boss and Tail Twisters.
 - You will be asked to introduce yourself to the Club at our weekly meeting.
 - You should be willing to participate in skits with Spirit Committee (Tail Twisters).
3. Meetings take place at noon each Tuesday at the Scottish Rite Building, 1101 70th Street, Lubbock or other location as designated. The Lubbock Lions Club will be happy to provide a letter to your teacher/counselor if you are missing school to attend a weekly meeting.
4. In addition to attending three weekly meetings, recipient is encouraged to participate in ongoing projects.
5. It is a **REQUIREMENT** that the recipient participate in a minimum of three of our annual events throughout the year, which could include, but are not limited to:
 - Pancake Festival
 - Kid Fish
 - 4th of July Flag Sales
 - Salvation Army Bell Ringing
 - Bark and Brew
 - Coats for Floats
 - Other Approved Service Project
6. Should the recipient be unwilling or unable to fulfill their duties during their term, the Lubbock Lions Club reserves the right to modify or forfeit the scholarship in accordance with the level of participation by the recipient. You will find that our members are very friendly and will welcome you at all Club meetings and events.

1. The email shall contain the following documents:

- Completed application in .pdf format with executed Video Submission Release and Liability Waiver.
- Two letters of recommendation from the letter’s author in .pdf format. Letters should come from the applicant’s teacher, principal, counselor, or other adults who may know you well, including a pastor, youth director, or other community leader familiar with your community/volunteer service and/or leadership. Recommendation letters may NOT come from a relative of the applicant.
- Video file with a link to YouTube.

1. Content and Organization Skills

- Relevance: Speech directly addresses the prompt or theme; demonstrates understanding of the Lions Club mission and scholarship purpose.
- Clarity of Message: Main ideas are well-developed, logical, and easy to follow.
- Structure: Clear introduction, body, and conclusion; smooth transitions between points.

2. Delivery and Communication Skills

- Vocal Clarity: Clear, audible, and appropriate pacing; avoids monotone or filler words.
- Confidence and Poise: Demonstrates confidence, sincerity, and enthusiasm without being overly rehearsed.
- Eye Contact/Engagement: Looks into camera naturally; connects with audience.

3. Creativity and Impact

- Originality: Unique perspective, personal experiences, or creative storytelling.
- Emotional Appeal: Inspires, motivates, or resonates with the audience.

4. Technical Quality of Video

- Audio/Visual Quality: Speech is easy to hear and see; minimal distractions.
- Professionalism: Appropriate setting, attire, and respectful tone.

5. Adherence to Guidelines

- Time Limit: Stays within required time.
- Submission Requirements: Meets all directions (format, file type, deadline, etc.)
